Simmo's Tyre Tips

As car owners/drivers we rely on the Warrant of Fitness (WOF) testing procedure to alert us to existing and upcoming issues with our vehicle's road worthiness. This in itself is a good robust system, but what must be kept in perspective is this WOF is only as good as the day it was done.

What I mean by that is your vehicle (when tested) complied and is safe to drive. If you were to break a headlight on your vehicle it now doesn't comply; same goes for tyres - they were legal on that day but that doesn't mean you are ok until the next WOF check (which could be 6 months to 3 years dependant on the vehicles age). It is your responsibility as owner/driver to make sure your car, bus, truck, ute, whatever you drive is kept up to the required standard.

Take a look next time you are driving at night as to how many vehicles you see with one headlight out or brake lights not working properly. The owner may not even know, so our advice would be periodically check your own vehicle that all the basics work and your tyres are good. Or call on us and we can check for you. It might save you an issue with your insurance company if you had an accident and your car was not in a warrantable condition.

Have you budgeted in the tyre cost on that new vehicle?

When you buy a new vehicle, what you thought was a bargain might end up costing you a whole lot more in terms of tyre costs and maintenance, especially with European cars. For example, a bargain used BMW X5 runs very large, staggered fitment tyres. And they're not tyres you can pick up for a couple of hundred bucks a pop – so do your homework first and factor in what it's going to cost you to replace those 4 tyres.

Roasted Tomato Soup

1.5kg ripe tomatoes
Half diced onion
Half diced red pepper
2 tbsp olive oil
4 large cloves garlic (whole)
1 tsp dried oregano
1 tsp dried basil
Salt & pepper

2 cups chicken stock 2 tbsp fresh basil leaves Half cup cream Grated parmesan cheese

Heat oven to 275 deg Celsius. Cut tomatoes into quarters or 8ths if they are large. Put tomatoes, garlic, onion, red pepper, dried herbs, olive oil, salt & pepper on a large roasting tray and cook for about half an hour, stirring after 15 minutes. Turn oven to grill and get some char on them for about 5 minutes. Remove from oven.

Bring the chicken stock to boil in a large pot. Remove from heat. Add the tomato mixture and fresh basil. Combine, then with a stick blender blend everything until it's smooth and creamy. Add the cream and serve with grated parmesan cheese on top.
